This survey was conducted by Back to Belmore volunteers in April 2013 by telephone, doorknocking and streetwalking among local residents within a 2-kilometre radius of Belmore Sports Ground. Households and individuals were selected at random. The data has been weighed to reflect the population distribution of Belmore and the surrounding area. This survey is based on 500 interviews among residents. The survey has been undertaken biannually since 2006, following a pilot survey conducted in October 2005.
